



Sightseeing

Enjoy this fascinating journey which takes you through some of the highlights of South Italy.

Day 1: Rome

Arrive in Rome and transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Rome.

Day 2: Rome - Naples - Pompeii - Sorrento (265 Kilometres)

Depart early morning from Rome for Naples. After a short visit continue on to Pompeii, the famous Roman city destroyed by the volcanic eruption of Mount Vesuvius in 79 A.D. After lunch we visit the excavation sites and proceed to Sorrento. Dinner and overnight in Sorrento.

Day 3: Sorrento - Capri - Sorrento

Start the day heading to Capri by boat and visit the Blue Grotto (weather conditions permitting). Return to Marina Grande and enjoy lunch in an authentic local restaurant at Anacapri, followed by a visit to Augustus' Gardens, which has a view of the Faraglioni. Return to Sorrento. Dinner and overnight in Sorrento.

Day 4: Sorrento - Rende (Cosenza) (255 kilometres)

Spend your morning at leisure. In the afternoon, depart to Rende to visit the magnificent Aragonese Castles. Dinner and overnight in Rende.

Day 5: Rende (Cosenza) – Taormina (185 kilometres)

After breakfast, depart to the beautiful town of Taormina and spend some

time at leisure. Overnight and dinner in Taormina or Giardini Naxos.

Day 6: Taormina – Etna – Syracuse – Taormina (230 kilometres)

Depart for an excursion to Mount Etna, the highest volcano in Europe, up to the 'Rifugio Sapienza', 1,900 metres above sea level. Continue to Syracuse, for a guided visit of the Neapolis Greek Theatre, the Roman Amphitheatre and the Ear of Dionysus, an ear-shaped grotto. Dinner and overnight in Taormina.

Day 7: Taormina - Piazza Armerina - Agrigento (220 kilometres)

Today enjoy a guided tour of the Roman Villas of Piazza Armerina with their beautiful mosaics, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Then depart to Agrigento to admire the Valley of Temples. Dinner and overnight in Agrigento.

Day 8: Agrigento - Monreale - Palermo (180 kilometres)

After breakfast, leave for Palermo. Your first stop is Monreale for a guided visit of the outstanding Moorish-Norman style Duomo, extensively decorated with mosaics and fine gold. After lunch continue to Palermo for a panoramic visit of the city and then transfer to the airport for your flight to Rome and onward departure flight. You also have the option of extending your stay in Rome.

Total distance: 1,335 kilometres.



Day 1: Rome

Arrive in Rome and transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Rome.

Day 2: Rome — Assisi — Siena — Florence (380 Kilometres) Depart early morning for ancient Assisi, where the Basilica houses renaissance masterpieces by Giotto and Cimabue. Visit mediaeval Siena



before dinner. Overnight in Florence.

Day 3: Florence

A guided sightseeing tour of Piazza del Duomo, Santa Maria del Fiore Cathedral, Giotto's Bell Tower, St John's Baptistery, Michelangelo's 'David' in the Academy of Fine Arts and Cimabue's Crucifix in 13th century Santa Croce. Spend the rest of the day at your leisure, sightseeing or shopping. Overnight in Florence.

Day 4: Florence — Padua — Venice (250 Kilometres)

Depart for Venice via Padua; visit St Anthony's Cathedral, before your guided walking tour of Venice, including St Mark's Piazza and Basilica, Doge's Palace, Bridge of Sighs, the Prisons and a glass factory. Overnight in Venice.

Day 5: Venice

Spend the day at your leisure (optional excursion available). Overnight in Venice.

Day 6: Venice

Transfer to the airport for your departure flight. You also have the option of extending your stay in this romantic city.

In its 2,500 years, Rome has acquired a marvellous concentration of history, architecture and legend. While visitors are awed by the city's magnificent temples, churches, piazzas, mausoleums, baths and arches, Romans seem unaffected by the city's intimate link with the past. Known as the eternal city, you will find masterpieces of Roman architecture in the world-famous Roman Forum and Colosseum, Circus Maximus, Qurinial Palace, Trevi Fountain, Michelangelo ceiling in the Sistine Chapel and other reminders of ancient glory. These monuments mark Rome as the capital of Italy and the cultural centre of the ancient world. The works of great architects Barromini and Bernini - masters of Baroque-style, have left an amazing mark on the city. The historic centre of Rome is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Today, Rome is a modern, cosmopolitan city, one of the most visited tourist destinations in Europe and is also considered one of Europe's most exciting cities.

Places of interest: Spanish Steps, Colosseum, Forum, Vatican City and St Peter's Basilica, the Pantheon, Trevi Fountain, Piazza Navona and Villa Borghese gardens.

Best buys: High fashionwear available at Via Veneto; Via Sistina near



Spanish Steps on Via Condotti; streets between Piazza di Spagna and Via del Corso are lined with moderately-priced shops.

Out and about: Trastevere's narrow mediaeval streets, great for bars and dining; and Ludovisi's nightclubs and restaurants.



Naples and Capri Full-day seat-in-coach excursion with lunch

Your excursion begins from Rome with a drive along the **Autostrada del Sole** through the Roman, Ciociarian, (where you will see the **Abbey of Montecassino** perched on its mountain top) and **Campanian countryside** to Naples, where you board your steamer and cross the Bay of Naples to enchanting **Capri**. This limestone island's rocks have been eroded by the sea and the weather into fantastic formations.





Disembark at Capri's pretty harbour; weather and sea conditions permitting, you board a small boat to visit the **Blue Grotto**, a sea-filled cave where the reflections of the morning light turn the water into a shimmering, iridescent blue.

After returning to **Marina Grande**, a minibus will take you on a comprehensive tour of the island, including the flower-bedecked town of Capri packed with white-painted houses, jewellery shops and designer boutiques set around its ancient central square. We then move on to **Anacapri**, situated on the slopes of Mount Solaro for fantastic views of the island and **Bay of Naples**.

After lunch in a local restaurant, there is plenty of free time to explore and go shopping.

This coach excursion includes pick-up and drop-off at the hotel with an English-speaking guide. This excursion operates in summer only.


Naples and Pompeii

Full-day seat-in-coach excursion with lunch

You will be picked up in the morning by coach from your hotel and drive south along the **Autostrada del Sole**, following the route of the **Roman Via Casilina** behind the coastal mountains. En route we pass **Castelli Romani**, where the hillsides are devoted to vineyards and the **Abbey of Montecassino** (totally destroyed in World War II but now rebuilt and spectacularly perched high on its mountain top). We continue via Naples, located between the sea and Mount Vesuvius, to Pompeii.

After lunch in a local restaurant, we visit the remains of the Roman city,





completely destroyed by a titanic eruption on 24th August AD 79, considered to be Mount Vesuvius' most powerful eruption. **Pompeii** was buried under the stones and ash of the eruption, becoming a time capsule of the Roman period. Almost everything we know today about the daily life of the ancient Romans has been learned from here. Pompeii is no mere ruin, walking along the old Roman high street you can peek into shops, read the graffiti on the walls and explore the homes of the ancient inhabitants.

This coach excursion includes pick-up and drop-off at the hotel with an English-speaking guide.



The Vatican City Half-day seat-in-coach excursion

This fascinating tour reveals the splendours of the Vatican City. Sprawling over a hill west of the River Tiber and separated from the rest of Rome by a wall, it covers a total area of only slightly more than 40 hectares. Although it is the world's smallest independent sovereign state, the wealth of treasures



and history it contains would be the envy of many large countries.

St Peter's Basilica, believed to be the largest church building in Christianity, covers an area of 2.3 hectares and has a capacity to accommodate over 60,000 people. The magnificent façade and the huge dome provide just a hint of the spectacular interior. St Peter's Square, the open space in front of the Basilica lined by four-deep rows of Tuscan colonnades can accommodate 300,000 people.

The Vatican Palace, the official residence of the Pope, is a complex of buildings, comprising of the Papal Apartment, several chapels and the Vatican Museum and Library. In all there are over 1,000 rooms of which the most famous include the Raphael's Rooms and the Sistine Chapel with its renowned ceiling frescoes painted by Michelangelo.
